



### Overview:

The Doxazo Summer Intensive (DSI) is a three-month experience designed to equip, empower, and engage followers of Jesus to live the Gospel in a broken world. Students who participate in DSI will be equipped to live out the Gospel through both individual and group Bible study. Students will then take their knowledge and be empowered to live out the Gospel through a family group, as well as the larger DSI family, who will encourage them in their walk. Students will also get engaged by having the opportunity to practice living out the Gospel through weekly service sites where they will be able to interact with children and show them what it means to be a follower of Jesus.

**Who:** Students entering their freshmen year of high school to senior year of college

**When:** May 26-August 4

**Cost:** \$350 (Pays for Retreat, Books, Summer Life Activities, Mission Trip)

### Expectations:

**Students are expected to attend the following events:**

- DSI Retreat from May 26-28
- Weekly Monday night dinners, worship and Biblical training (Doxazo Summer Life)
- Weekly Tuesday-Thursday service sites (**Must serve one day a week**)
- Weekly family group time.

**Additionally, students are expected to:**
